What do Irving Berlin, Duke Ellington, Elvis and the Beatles have in common?

The answer is they each had the formula to put their music at the **Top of the Charts**.

Top of the Charts is a two-hour journey down memory lane and a tribute to the power of popular music. **SIXFEETUP** has the vocal, instrumental and technical expertise to transport audiences all the way back to the roots of American music and take them through the big band and rock and roll eras right up to the great sounds of the 70s and 80s. We feature excerpts from over 55 songs along with stories and anecdotes drawn from extensive research of the personalities, trends and influences of the times. The first half opens with traditional turn-of-the-century styles and ends with the rock and roll revolution of the 50s. After a 15-minute intermission, Elvis storms the stage and we continue with the Beatles, Motown, even some Disco and Smooth Jazz.
